

Are Your Fans Compliant?

California Title 20

Commercial and industrial fans and blowers manufactured on or after **April 29, 2024**, must comply with the testing, marking, reporting, and efficiency requirements listed in Sections 1601-1609 of California's Appliance Efficiency Regulations (Title 20).



Exhaust fans with 1HP motor or GREATER must be labeled and have a 1.00 FEI (Fan Energy Index) or HIGHER.



Department of Energy Test Procedure for Fans and Blowers must be performed on all regulated fans.

Regulated fans and blowers must be listed in the Modernized Appliance Efficiency Database (MAEDbS) to be sold or offered for sale in California.

*Even if a fan or blower meets all Title 20 testing and marking requirements, it is **illegal** to sell or offer for sale a regulated product in California if the model is not listed the MAEDbS.*

**Testing must be completed in a lab that is also registered in MAEDbS.*

U.S. Department of Energy

The Department of Energy published a Notice of Proposed Rule Making on **January 19, 2024**, with similar requirements to California's. Once enacted, this rule will apply to an even larger number of commercial and industrial fans and blowers with **more stringent efficiency minimums**.
